Topic: Opening Prayer & Spiritual Formation

Topic: Goal Review and Accountability Conversation - Connor Williams

Discussion: Connor is continuing to work with Washington Street Baptist to develop a joint society meeting. There are 4 members from LOUMC and 3 members from Washington Street are participating.

Topic: Financial Review – Financial Report

Discussion: David Pope reviewed the financial report. Focus on Special Mission Fund Account. Review of items on the spreadsheet. David Pope will ask Christy about Disaster Relief, Food Pantry and Purchase District. Connor checking on Dayshore, payment for Hotel Metropolitan for Civil Rights tour and Stay Ministry. The Budget Committee will come up with a proposal to clean up the spreadsheet.

Expenses for May were \$22,008.14 with offerings were \$24,469.57 for net of \$2461. Currently year-to-date offerings are approximately \$7000 greater than expenses.
