**Topic: Opening Prayer & Spiritual Formation**

**Topic: Report on Children's Ministry - Jennie Beth Morehead**

Children's Sunday school class has children from ages 3 to 12. There is a need for an adult to oversee the youth who are covering the nursery. A camera is being added to nursery.
